

Clair Memorial Church Reopening



We are taking serious safety precautions and monitoring the rise of the Omicron variant. As we return, it is important to establish an environment that provides safety and comfort for both those attending service and volunteers working on Sunday mornings. After much prayer and careful planning, we have implemented the following safety protocols. I encourage you to review this entire document.

Three-step check-in process upon arrival

- Temperature check required for all persons entering the building
- All guests will sign a contact tracing sheet
- All guests will sanitize hands We recommend everyone wash their hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer upon arrival and each time upon exit and re-entry of the building.

Sanctuary

- Masks are mandatory for all persons and will be worn at all times on the premises. We will provide masks to our members/guests if needed.
- We diligently enforce on-site social distancing measures. All guests will be seated in every other row. Persons in the same household may sit together.
- · Limited movement during the service
- Each in-person service will be recorded for our online viewing audience.
- Only plan to come to church if you are not, and for a period of 14 days prior have not, experienced any symptoms related to COVID-19.
